All Students MUST have a student visa to participate in this program.

Students arriving without a visa will be sent home by immigration officials at your own expense.

YOU are solely responsible for obtaining your visa ON TIME for your program.

Please take this process seriously.

The following set of instructions applies to U.S. citizens ONLY

If you are **NOT** a U.S. Citizen, you will need to research the visa requirements for your nationality.

What You Will Need TO DO:

- ➤ **READ** information on this instruction sheet and **CONSULATE WEBSITE**: http://overseas.mofa.go.kr/us-newyork-en/index.do
- **➤ YOU MAY APPLY BY MAIL OR IN PERSON THE CHOICE IS YOURS!**
- MAKE AN APPOINTMENT with the consulate if presenting your documents in person (instructions below).
- > GATHER all of the supporting documentation (and copies) for your visa application
- ➤ **APPLY IN PERSON or BY MAIL** through the Republic of Korea Consulate in New York City. As a Dickinson student, you have standing in NYC; if you need another consulate, you will need to research the consulate that has jurisdiction over your area.
- > RECEIVE your passport back from the consulate and ensure that your visa is correct

Step 1: Prepare by Collecting Necessary Documentation

- > Consult Korea's New York City consulate website (listed above) for list of requirements
- Complete the Visa Application form from the Consulate website (above)
- Gather appropriate documents for the appointment
 - o Prioritize some documents take longer to obtain!

Step 2: APPLY! Either in person or by mail.

- APPLY in person for your visa at the New York Consulate. It can take up to six weeks to receive your visa from the time of your appointment.
- > SEND YOUR MATERIALS TO THE APPROPRIATE CONSULATE, IF APPLYING BY MAIL. Application materials must be <u>complete</u> before sending them to the consulate. Any error in your paperwork could jeopardize your application or cause serious delays in processing. If you want to have your passport with the visa mailed back to you, enclose a self-addressed and pre-paid envelope provided by the U.S. Postal Service Express Mail; be sure to request a tracking number.
 - Note: please check the Jurisdiction for the Korean Consular Office in your area.

YOU WILL NEED TO SURRENDER YOUR PASSPORT IN ORDER TO GET YOUR VISA!

Do not plan to travel internationally during this time.

Copy of your flight itinerary	You	Not necessary for the visa, but highly recommended.
Embassy Fees of \$45 for U.S. citizens (cash or money order only) *fee can vary; check the consulate website for changes	You	Money orders should be made payable to: Korean Embassy
Letter of Invitation/Admission (from Yonsei University)	CGSE (from Yonsei)	CGSE will mail this to you once it is received.
Dickinson Letter of Acceptance	CGSE	Will state purpose of travel, dates, expenses covered (room, board, tuition), etc.
Self-addressed and pre-paid mailing envelope from the USPS	You	If you are mailing in your visa application, you need to include this. You do not need to include this if you will drop/off and pick up your passport with visa. This must be an Express Mail Envelope from the U.S. Postal Service for the return of your passport and visa from the Korean Consulate. Make sure you write down the tracking information.

Normally it takes 10 business days to process a visa after the application submission.

Money orders and pre-paid Express Mail envelopes can be purchased at the Carlisle Post Office at 66 W. Louther St.
