All Students **MUST** have a student visa to participate in this program.
Students arriving without a visa will be sent home by immigration officials at your own expense.
YOU are solely responsible for obtaining your visa **ON TIME** for your program.
Please take this process seriously.

The following set of instructions applies for U.S. citizens ONLY

If you are **NOT** a U.S. Citizen, you will need to research the visa requirements for your nationality.

What You Will Need TO DO:

- **READ** information on this instruction sheet and **CONSULATE WEBSITE**:

- **YOU MAY APPLY BY MAIL OR IN PERSON – THE CHOICE IS YOURS!**
- **MAKE AN APPOINTMENT** with the consulate if presenting your documents in person (instructions below).
- **GATHER** all of the supporting documentation (and copies) for your visa application
- **APPLY IN PERSON or BY MAIL** through the Republic of Korea Consulate in New York City (as a Dickinson student, you have standing in NYC; if needing another consulate, check jurisdictions at:
<http://usa.mofat.go.kr/english/am/usa/visa/office/index.jsp>
- **RECEIVE** your passport back from the consulate and ensure that your visa is correct

Step 1: Prepare by Collecting Necessary Documentation

- Consult Korea's New York City consulate website (listed above) for list of requirements
- Complete the **Visa Application** form from the Consulate website (above)
- Gather appropriate documents for the appointment
 - Prioritize – some documents take longer to obtain!

Step 2: APPLY! Either in person or by mail.

- **APPLY** in person for your visa at the New York Consulate. It can take up to six weeks to receive your visa from the time of your appointment.
- **SEND YOUR MATERIALS TO THE APPROPRIATE CONSULATE, IF APPLYING BY MAIL.** Application materials must be complete before sending them to the consulate. Any error in your paperwork could jeopardize your application or cause serious delays in processing. If you want to have your passport with the visa mailed back to you, enclose a self-addressed and pre-paid envelope provided by the U.S. Postal Service Express Mail; be sure to request a tracking number.
 - Note: please check the Jurisdiction for the Korean Consular Office in your area.

YOU WILL NEED TO SURRENDER YOUR PASSPORT IN ORDER TO GET YOUR VISA!

Do not plan to travel internationally during this time.
